2. Turn left out of the parking lot on Lewis Lane
3. Turn right on Stillwater Road in front of the elementary school
4. Turn left onto loop 286
5. Take Clarksville Street exit (bus. 271)
6. Turn right onto 33<sup>rd</sup> Street
7. 1155 is the third house on the right ...  
use the long side walk to enter into the FRONT of the house.

#### **From Crockett Middle School:**

1. Start from the main parking lot
2. Turn left on Collegiate
3. Turn left on Clarksville Street
4. Turn left onto 33<sup>rd</sup> Street
5. 1155 is the third house on the right ...

#### **From Chisum High School:**

1. Start from the parking lot in front of the high school
